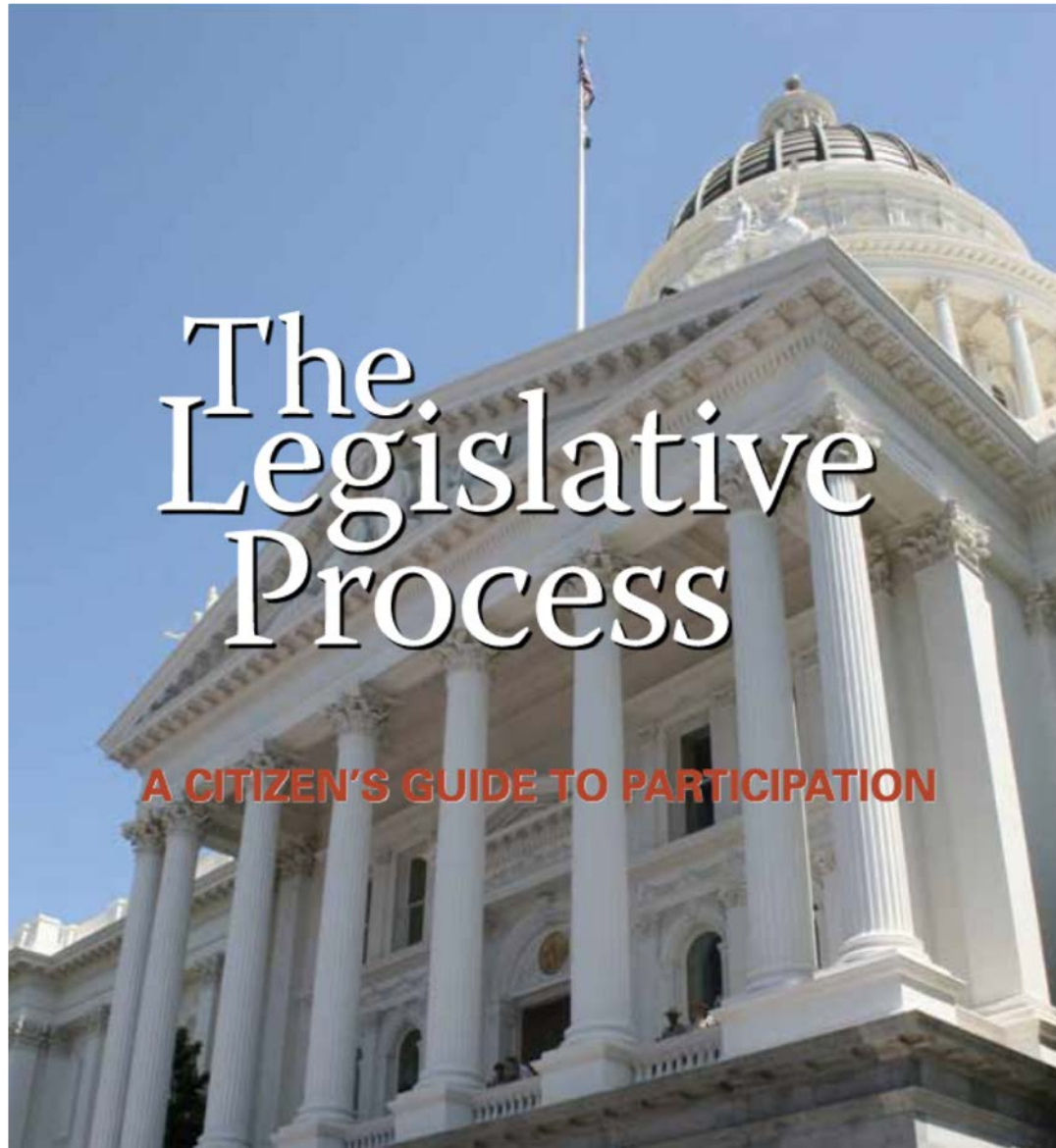

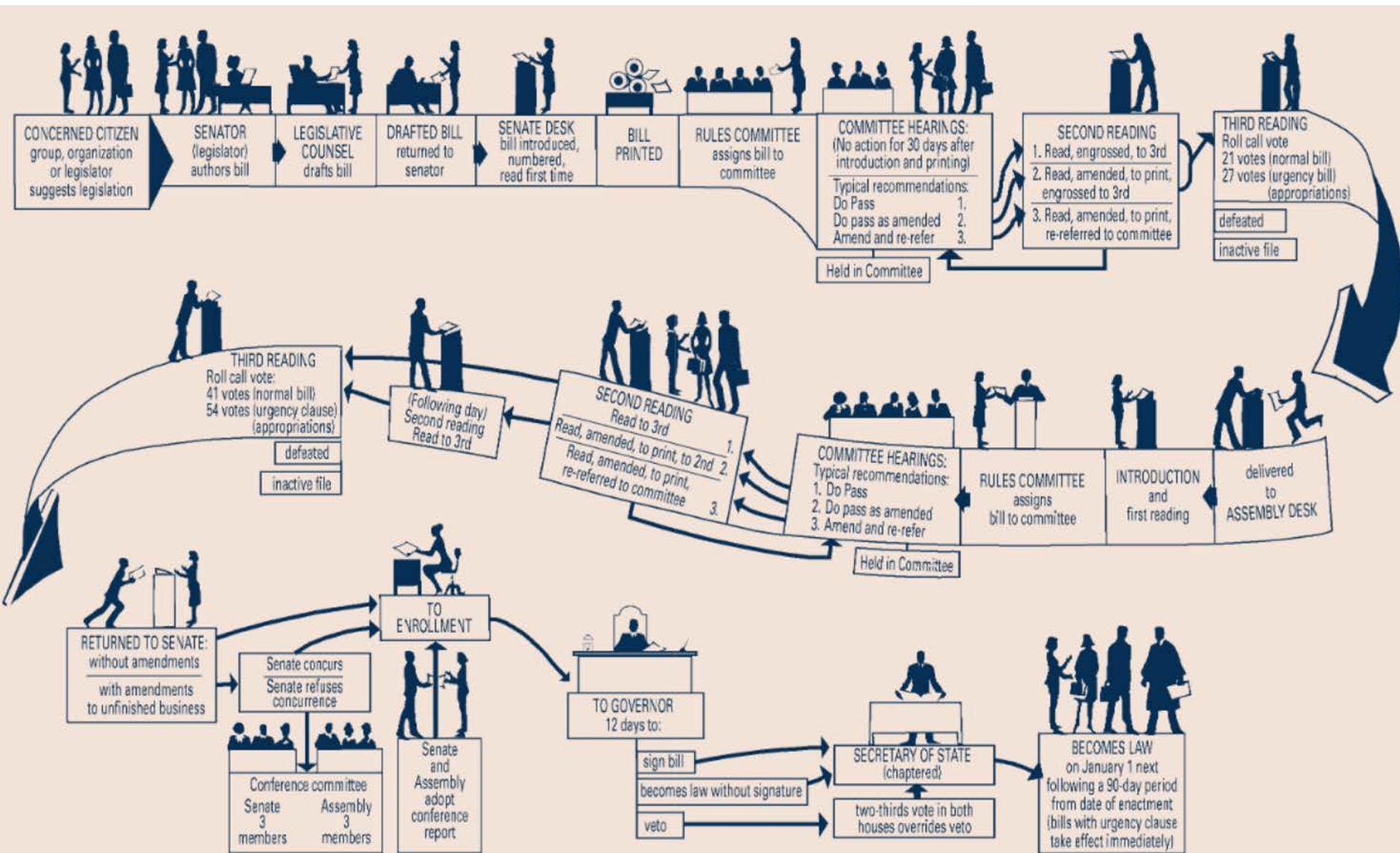

- Goes to committees for discussion in both the Senate and the assembly
- Floor vote in both the Senate and Assembly after they get out of the committees
- Governor signs or vetoes the bill

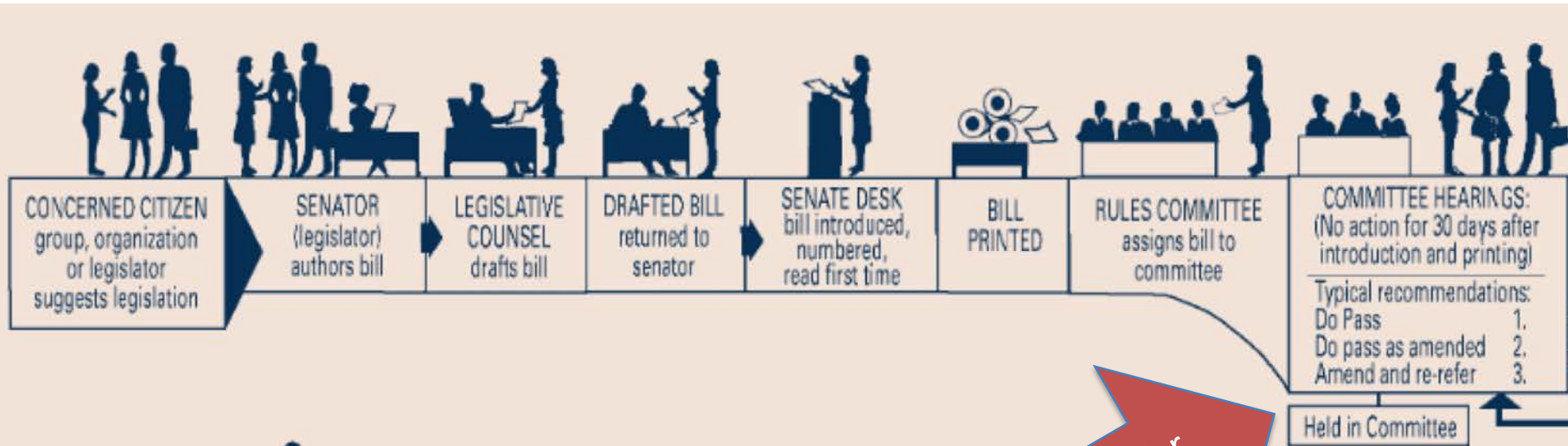
